

THE TORRES MARTINEZ GAMING COMMISSION

1. **License Application Fees:** The Torres Martinez Gaming Commission (TMGC) shall set the gaming licensing fees as deemed applicable and appropriate. Setting fee amounts will be the sole responsibility of the TMGC. The TMGC shall set licensing fees for Gaming Licensees and applicable vendors. Gaming Operations/Casino Management shall be responsible for collecting and paying all employee gaming licensing fees.
2. **Initial License Fee Payments:** Licensing fees shall be paid by Casino Operations to the Torres Martinez Tribal Fiscal Division. These fees shall be credited to the TMGC.
3. **Renewal License Fees:** License renewal fees are due and payable biannually upon license renewal. Renewal fees will be processed in the same manner as *Initial License Fee Payments*, as stated in this regulation.
4. **Fee Increases:** The TMGC may annually adjust the amount of all license application fees by an amount not exceeding ten percent (10%) of the annual rate. The increase shall take effect at the start of each annual budget year. Fee increases are allowed only to ensure that the license fee covers the cost of performing a background check.
5. **License Fee Schedule:** The license fee schedule shall be published as an appendix to these regulations. The licensing fees schedule shall be reviewed annually by the TMGC, with recommendations for modifications (increase or decrease) to the TMGC. The TMGC shall have final approval for any fee adjustments or modifications. If the license fee schedule is modified, the appendix must be updated, and a notice must be sent to Casino Operations indicating that the fee schedule has been changed. This appendix will not be posted for comment. (Refer to Licensing Fee Schedule Appendix A)
6. **Licensing Fee Deposits:** The Head of TGA shall send a licensing fee invoice monthly to Casino Operations. Casino Operations shall pay all fees to the Torres Martinez Tribe. All payments must be credited to the Gaming Commission's account. The licensing fees collected shall be used to support the TMGC annual budget directly

7. **Vendor License Fee:** Vendors shall be responsible for all license fees and any additional fees that TGA may incur in the process of performing the initial and renewal background checks. This applies to the Company, principals, technicians, subsidiaries, DBAs, or any other entity under the company's corporate umbrella that is required to be licensed by the TMGC in accordance with these regulations.
8. **Vendor Licensee Adjustments/Increases:** The Commission may annually adjust the amount of the Vendor's license initial or renewal application fee.
9. **Vendor License Fees:** Refer to Appendix A for vendor fees. This includes the Company Principal and Technicians. Vendor renewal license fees will remain the same as the initial license fee. The TMGC reserves the right to adjust Vendor license fees.

GAMING LICENSING APPLICATION FEE SCHEDULE

Primary Management Officials (PMO) & Key Employees (KE)

All New and Renewal Applicants will be subject to TMGA's licensing fees unless otherwise stated in writing or waived by the TMGA. Licensing Fees are as follows:

1. New Applicant PMO - \$1,000.00
2. State Key - \$500.00
3. Non-Key - \$350.00 and \$200.00
4. All Renewals - \$100.00

Casino Vendors

The Tribal Gaming License Fee structure was approved by the Torres Martinez Gaming Commission (TMGC) on June 23, 2009. These fees cover the two (2) year period. Payment in full or evidence of another prearrangement with the TMGC must accompany the application.

1. Company - \$2,000.00
2. Principal - \$500.00
3. Technician - \$250.00
4. All Renewals – Same as initial

Casino Corporate Board Members: No fees will be assessed at this time.

Torres Martinez Gaming Commission (TMGC) Members: No fees will be assessed at this time.

Tribal Gaming Agency (TGA) Members: No fees will be assessed at this time.
